Report of The Forestry and Environment Working Group

Heart of Borneo

1. Three countries (Brunei Darussalam, Indonesia and Malaysia) agreed to held a trilateral meeting on HOB tentatively scheduled between mid to end of June 2007 in Brunei Darussalam. Malaysia reported the progress of the HoB implementation. The report appears as **Annex A**
2. The agenda of trilateral meeting:
 - Establishment of HOB secretariat will be rotated for a couple of years among the Indonesia, Malaysia and Brunei Darussalam.
 - The progress in preparing the Project/planning documents for HOB implementation
3. To maintaining good communication, each country proposed a contact person from the ministries and agency as below:
 - The Director of Forestry, Ministry of Industry and Primary Resources, Brunei Darussalam
 - Mr. Noor Hidayat, Director of Area Conservation, DG of Forest Protection and Nature Conservation, Ministry of Forestry-Indonesia
 - Forestry Division, Ministry of Natural Resources and Environment - Malaysia
 - The Executive Director of MedCo (Janet Lopez), Philippines.
4. Discussion on Road Map of Development:
 - HOB not only about conservation, but also sustainable natural resources. Sustainable development is important part of HOB
 - Indonesia proposed that the next steps in the HOB are also to strengthen the on going cooperation in existing transboundary project among three countries.

Cross border Emergency response mechanism

1. Each country will study on the document prepared by ADB and to propose what type of assistant is needed by each particular country to be brought forward to BIMP Facilities Centre.
2. ADB advise, it's better for Brunei, Indonesia, Malaysia and Philippine to adopt this initiative as regional initiative.

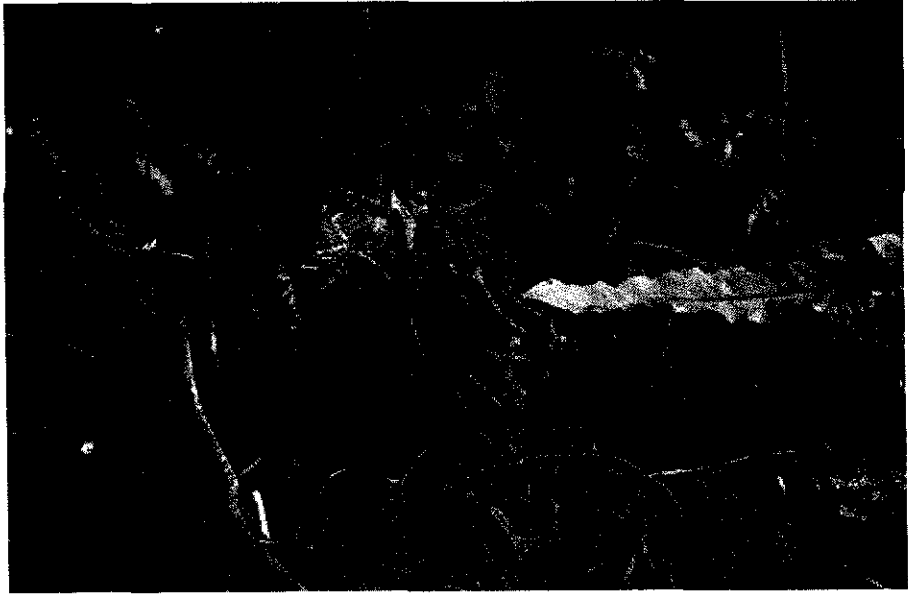
Coral Triangle
